

LIST OF REQUIREMENTS FOR TRADE SHOWS AND EVENTS INVOLVING MACHINERY AND THE USE OF CHEMICAL SUBSTANCES

(Note: This checklist is applicable to machines that carry out demonstrations and use/storage/exhibition and commercialization of chemical substances)



This list is designed as support material for you to verify compliance with the requirements applicable to activities related to demonstrations of machinery or commissioning and the use/storage/exhibition and commercialization of chemical substances, which are carried out in the CORFERIAS fairground and its complementary areas, in accordance with the provisions of Law 9 of 1979, other applicable health regulations and the results of the technical meetings held with the support of the District Health Secretariat for the health surveillance of the fairground.

Consider that all the regulations that update or repeal the regulations mentioned here and the other applicable regulations, even if they are not related in this document, will be subject to compliance during the development of the trade show or event and it will be your responsibility to consult and follow up on them.

ASPECTS TO VERIFY

DOCUMENTS

(Demonstration of Machinery, Chemical Substances)

It has the data sheets of the machine (digital or physical) in Spanish, which must include the recommendations for use and safety.

The exhibitor must have available (digital or physical) the safety data sheets of the chemical substances stored or used for the operation or maintenance of any machine, exhibition and/or commercialization. Said documents must be in Spanish language and contain the 16 aspects defined by the Globally Harmonized System, which was adopted for Colombia by means of Decree 1496 of 2018, a standard that also establishes that manufacturers or importers must supply it.

FACILITIES

Consider that the machines in operation cannot be superimposed on absorbent surfaces (mat), therefore, a rigid floor in sanitary material, smooth, non-porous, non-absorbent must be guaranteed; if this floor does not support the weight of the machine, you can use a PVC or plastic mat.

If the machine generates any type of emission during or after the demonstration, always ask the Corferias commercial area for a location near a site with adequate natural ventilation, if this is not possible, it must have a mechanism that allows extraction emissions and ventilation in the area where the machine is located.

Chemical substances must be stored within the stand and in the exhibitor's cellar on rigid surfaces or floors, and easy to clean and disinfect, marked, and always separated from any type of food or drink, such as water, packaged food, coffee, sweets, etc. Regarding the walls and ceilings

Within the stand or exhibitor's cellar, you must have available an anti-spill kit that is suitable for the chemical substance you are handling during the trade show or event, according to the recommendations given in the safety data sheet.

SECURITY MEASURES IN THE WORK AREA

When demonstrating the machine, it is important to demarcate a security zone to prevent visitors from accessing it and causing some kind of accident.

The machines must have all the necessary protection elements to avoid accidents during handling, such as security devices and guards.

You must have a fire extinguisher throughout the trade show/event according to the type of substance to be used or exhibited, according to the recommendations given by the safety data sheet.

INTEGRATED MANAGEMENT OF SOLID WASTE

Consider that the exhibitor is responsible for properly disposing of the chemical or machine waste. These cannot be discarded within the fairgrounds.

MACHINE OPERATING STAFF AND CHEMICAL HANDLER

They must always have the appropriate personal protection items to operate the machine and/or handle the chemical substances according to the safety information of each one. If the visitor requires in some fortuitous event to manipulate the machine, they must provide the same elements.

The operator must demonstrate that they know the data sheet and have training in the handling and/or demonstration of the machine or equipment, as well as in the handling of the chemical substances to be used, exhibited, or commercialized.

FOOD HANDLING INSIDE THE STAND

Dear Exhibitor, remember that it is very IMPORTANT that if you have demonstrations of machinery or chemical substances inside your stand and plan to offer your visitors any type of food or drink (ex. wine, ripened cheeses, peanuts, sweets, bottled water, coffee, etc.), it is necessary to make a separation and these do not come into contact at any time (stand - exhibitor's cellar), for the other requirements applicable in the handling of food such as documentation, drinking water points, floors, among others, see the attached list of requirements.

SECURITY MEASURES IN WORK AREAS

Appropriate Personal Protection Items (PPI) are selected and used, according to the risk, with characteristics, frequencies of appropriate use and are listed in the stand's biosafety manual.

DEFINITIONS

Substance: it is a chemical element and all its components in a natural state or obtained through any production process.

Label: a set of written, printed, or graphical information elements relating to a dangerous product.

NORMATIVITY

For more information on the requirements to be met, you can consult the following current regulations: The Globally Harmonized System, which was adopted for Colombia through Decree 1496 of 2018.
